Re: Update Regarding COVID-19

This update is a continuation from the statement released by the BINUS SCHOOL Education Office (Ref. No: 010/BSE/III/2020, dated 3 March 2020). This is also in support of previous statements released by BINUS SCHOOL in relation to COVID-19.

We have been closely monitoring the COVID-19 developments. To date, despite the temporary closure of some schools, BINUS SCHOOL remains operational with protocols in place to help keep the community as safe as possible until the next official update.

The Indonesian Ministry of Education and Culture has released a set of protocols (dated 9 March 2020) which BINUS schools will use as a reference for all actions (kindly refer to the appended files). Some of these actions appear below.

1. FAMILY TRAVEL

With respect to 010/BSE/III/2020 on travel to CDC countries at Levels 1-3, please be advised that students, personnel and/or respective family members who have returned to Indonesia following travel/transit to or from these countries must undergo a 14-day self-quarantine, as per CDC guideline (<https://www.cdc.gov/travel>). The period of self-quarantine will commence upon leaving and/or transiting from these countries.

2. HOME LEARNING

BINUS SCHOOL has prepared systems to enable students to engage in home learning in the event of an emergency closure.

In response to COVID-19 developments, all BINUS SCHOOLS will hold a planning day on Friday 13 March. On this day, all teachers will have a planning day to prepare materials for students' home learning if the need should arise. On 13 March, students will remain at home except Grade 12 students sitting for examinations. Classes at School will resume as normal on Monday 16 March, unless otherwise advised by BINUS SCHOOL.

3. SPECIAL EVENTS

In line with the set of protocols from the Indonesian Ministry of Education and Culture (dated 9 March 2020), any scheduled event may be restricted, postponed or cancelled.



4. IMMERSIONS/TRIPS

In line with the same set of protocols, please be advised that **all school immersions and trips (local and overseas) will be postponed or cancelled** until further notice. BINUS SCHOOL will be assisting to process refunds where available.

5. SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

At this time, it is imperative we practise social responsibility in order to promote safety and wellbeing within our homes as well as across our school community. **Everyone is encouraged to observe the health conditions of family and household members.** Proper diet, enough sleep, and exercise are still the best means to ensure good health.

Anyone experiencing severe flu or flu-like symptoms must go to the hospital for proper care (kindly refer to the Appendix). We require that the school will be informed of such matters so that appropriate advice can be given. Healthy individuals make for a healthy community.

6. SOCIAL DISTANCING

The term *social distancing* is used to refer to public health actions that are taken in order to stop or slow down the spread of a highly contagious disease. The objective is to reduce the probability of contact between infected persons. Simply applied, this means avoiding going to crowded places as much as possible unless necessary. This also means avoiding large gatherings or crowds whenever possible.

Dalam rangka pencegahan perkembangan dan penyebaran *Corona Virus Disease* (Covid-19) di lingkungan satuan pendidikan, dengan hormat kami mengimbau Saudara agar segera menginstruksikan kepada satuan pendidikan di wilayah kerja Saudara untuk:

1. mengoptimalkan peran Usaha Kesehatan Sekolah (UKS) atau unit layanan kesehatan di perguruan tinggi dengan cara berkoordinasi dengan fasilitas pelayanan kesehatan setempat dalam rangka pencegahan penyebaran Covid-19;
2. berkomunikasi dengan Dinas Kesehatan, Dinas Pendidikan dan/atau Lembaga Layanan Pendidikan Tinggi setempat untuk mengetahui apakah Dinas Kesehatan telah memiliki semacam rencana atau persiapan dalam menghadapi Covid-19;
3. memastikan ketersediaan sarana untuk cuci tangan pakai sabun (CTPS) dan alat pembersih sekali pakai (*tissue*) di berbagai lokasi strategis di satuan pendidikan;
4. memastikan bahwa warga satuan pendidikan menggunakan sarana CTPS (minimal 20 detik) dan pengering tangan sekali pakai sebagaimana mestinya, dan perilaku hidup bersih sehat (PHBS) lainnya;
5. memastikan satuan pendidikan melakukan pembersihan ruangan dan lingkungan satuan pendidikan secara rutin, khususnya handel pintu, saklar lampu, komputer, papan tik (*keyboard*) dan fasilitas lain yang sering terpegang oleh tangan. Gunakan petugas yang trampil menjalankan tugas pembersihan dan gunakan bahan pembersih yang sesuai untuk keperluan tersebut;
6. memonitor absensi (ketidakhadiran) warga satuan pendidikan;
7. memberikan izin kepada warga satuan pendidikan yang sakit untuk tidak datang ke satuan pendidikan;
8. tidak memberlakukan hukuman/sanksi bagi yang tidak masuk karena sakit, serta tidak memberlakukan kebijakan insentif berbasis kehadiran (jika ada);

9. melaporkan kepada Dinas Kesehatan, Dinas Pendidikan dan/atau Lembaga Layanan Pendidikan Tinggi jika terdapat ketidakhadiran dalam jumlah besar karena sakit yang berkaitan dengan pernafasan;
10. mengalihkan tugas pendidik dan tenaga kependidikan yang absen kepada pendidik dan tenaga kependidikan lain yang mampu;
11. berkonsultasi dengan Dinas Pendidikan atau Lembaga Layanan Pendidikan Tinggi jika level ketidakhadiran dianggap sangat mengganggu proses belajar-mengajar untuk mendapatkan pertimbangan apakah kegiatan belajar-mengajar perlu diliburkan sementara;
12. satuan pendidikan tidak harus mampu mengidentifikasi Covid-19. Kementerian Kesehatan yang akan melakukannya, sehingga satuan pendidikan harus melaporkan dugaan Covid-19 kepada Kementerian Kesehatan setempat untuk dilakukan pengujian. Perlu diingat bahwa, mayoritas penyakit terkait dengan pernafasan bukan merupakan Covid-19;
13. memastikan makanan yang disediakan di satuan pendidikan merupakan makanan yang sudah dimasak sampai matang;
14. mengingatkan seluruh warga satuan pendidikan untuk tidak berbagi makanan, minuman, dan alat musik tiup;
15. mengingatkan warga satuan pendidikan untuk menghindari kontak fisik langsung (bersalaman, cium tangan, berpelukan, dan sebagainya);
16. menunda kegiatan yang mengumpulkan banyak orang atau kegiatan di lingkungan luar satuan pendidikan (berkemah, studi wisata);
17. membatasi tamu dari luar satuan pendidikan;

Translated copy of *Surat Edaran Menteri Pendidikan dan Kebudayaan RI Nomor 3 Tahun 2020 Tentang Pencegahan Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) Pada Satuan Pendidikan*

To prevent the development and spread of COVID-19 in the area of an educational institution, we advise you to instruct the educational institution in your working area to:

1. Optimise the school clinic or health service unit in campus by coordinating with the local service unit to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
2. Communicate with the Health Office, Education Office and/or Higher Education Office to check whether the Health Ministry have plans to address COVID-19.
3. Ensure the availability of facilities for washing hands using water and soap and tissue in various strategic locations in school.
4. Ensure that members of the school community are using these facilities (minimum 20 seconds for hand washing) and use hand drier properly and practise proper hygiene as a habit.
5. Ensure that the educational institution cleans the rooms regularly, especially door handles, light switches, computers, keyboards and other facilities often touched by hands.
6. Monitor the absence of the members of the school community.
7. Allow members of the school community not to come to school if they are sick.
8. Not to impose penalties/ sanctions for any members of the school community who are absent due to illness, as well as do not reward anyone who will be present with a present-based incentive policy (if any).
9. Report to the Health Office, Education Office and/or Higher Education Office if there is a high number of absences of the school community members due to illness related to breathing.
10. Transfer the duties of educators and education staff who are absent to other education staff that is capable.
11. Consult with the Education Office and/or Higher Education Office if the level of absence is affecting the teaching-learning process. Need to consider whether the teaching-learning activities need to be temporarily suspended.
12. School is not required to identify COVID-19 cases. The Ministry of Health will be the one in charge, so the school just need to report possible COVID-19 cases to the Ministry for testing. Do remember that majority of health issues related to breathing is not COVID-19.
13. Ensure that the food provided at school is healthy and well cooked.
14. Urge all school community members not to share foods, drinks and music instruments.
15. Remind the school community members to avoid direct physical contact (shaking hands, kissing hands, hugging, etc.).
16. Postpone activities that require gathering of large number of people or activities outside the school (camping, study tours).
17. Limit the guests from outside of the educational institution.
18. School community members and their families traveling to countries with COVID-19 local transmission (published by World Health Organization) are asked not to do deliver, drop off, pickup, and be present in the school area for 14 days upon return to Indonesia.
